## Minutes of the January 28th, 2019 Meeting

41 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the November 26, 2019 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$5822.17; credits \$10,080.50; checking balance \$78,696.51.

New members - There was one new member at the meeting that introduced himself.

Jason Franzen spoke to the club. He is a Delano City Council member and he is running for Wright County Commissioner. Jason gave an overview on his policies.

Gravel mining/Ram Excavating -Tom talked to Neil - now they are asking Ram to do a lead measurement test on the area where the new trap range will be. This will not be able to be conducted until spring.

Elections of officers were held - Tom Delaney was nominated for President for another year, Dan Kittok was nominated for secretary for another year and Joe Kittok was nominated for treasurer for another year. All nominations passed.

Range Issues - There have been few complaints over the last couple months.

Farm - There are a couple projects to be done, one is to put a gate off of the Farmington access.

Building and Grounds - There will be a Building and Grounds meeting in February. We will try to break into two committees. One to help Mark with the new property and trap range and another to handle the existing club grounds. The meeting will be held after the regular meeting.

Membership - 86% of 2020 dues have been paid.

The Hatchet Jack shoot was cancelled.

The Executive Board will meet tonight after the regular meeting.

### Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
