

Meeting Minutes, June 30, 2020

25 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the May 26, 2020 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits 2023.78; credits \$8960.50; checking balance \$65,866.20.

New members - 3 new members were present at the meeting and introduced themselves.

Daniel Bravender - Wright County Planning Commissioner is running for Wright County County Commissioner. He spoke to the club regarding his message and approach to government.

Gravel mining - Still no returned call from Ram Excavating. The club is moving forward with working with Jay Johnson. Jay has been on the property doing boring and has found out there isn't as much gravel out there as once thought. There is an estimated 250,000 yards of gravel.

Trap range - Still moving forward with Jay Johnson. Jay found out through boring that the area where the clubhouse is to be built has muck below it.

Range issues - Thank you to Bob Pink who has been helping out with the portable targets. They are working out well. Joe Kittok has found soon arborvitae to plant along the wall of the 25 yard range.

Membership - 497 members, 84 honorary members. New membership has been busy lately.

Summer Camps - The club had signed up 10 students for summer camps this year. All summer camps have been cancelled. Jan Kittok would like to make sure that the students from this year get the first opportunity to go next year if they want.

Trap League - Summer trap league continues. Trapshooting participants signed a Covid-19 waiver of liability and indemnification to protect the club. There were no issues from anyone signing it.

Fourth of July - Everything for the Delano celebration has been cancelled by the Fourth of July Committee. There will be a drive through parade taking place on the fourth though. Phase one - The Legion color guard will be walking the parade route as they have always done. Phase two - Any business or establishments that want to drive the parade route can do so. There

will be no politics, no walking the route and no candy. Staging will start at the Delano High School at 10:00 AM, the parade will start at about 11:00 AM. The Sportsmen's Club will be participating, Dan MacDonald will be driving his fire truck through again.

GOCRA & MNGOPAC - Dan MacDonald updated the club. There is not much happening now with the legislature being out of session.



Range Rules:

1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
4. No Paintball guns
5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
8. Do not dig in the backstops.
9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
10. **Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.**
11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
