# **Honoring Military March**


This month we recognize LTC (retired) R. R. "Ben" Benson.

Ben enlisted in the Army in November of 1967 and served three years, mostly on Okinawa.

In 1971 he reenlisted in the active Army Reserve and received his commission in the Army National Guard in 1977. He retired in October 1999 as the Commander of the 682nd Engineer Battalion, Minnesota Army National Guard.

While he was serving, he was a competitive marksman. In 1988, he shot a sub-caliber practice match at the club in preparation for the Minnesota Governor's Ten Rifle Match. The next day, he earned the Governor's Ten, a top honor in over ten years of competitive shooting. That great memory returns every time he has an opportunity to shoot at the club!

In Washington, it is HR 127.

#### **Range Rules:**

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
