Honoring Military March

This month we recognize Mess Management Specialist Chief Petty Officer. (ret) David D. Smith "Navy Davy".

Dave enlisted in the Navy after High School in 1971, he signed up and 2 weeks later he was gone to Boot Camp. He served 4 years Regular Navy, at NAS Adak Alaska and on the USS Gurke DD-783, a destroyer homeported in Yokosuka Japan.

In 1980 he enlisted in the Naval Air Reserve at Joint Base Detroit Michigan, with Naval Patrol Squadron 93. He retired in 1999 from the Naval Air Reserve Center MPLS., as the Acting Food Service Officer.

Prior to the Navy, shot competitively with the 21^{st} Michigan Volunteer In-

fantry, a Civil War History unit, shooting Military Black Powder rifles.

Minutes of March 30th Meeting

30 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the February 23, 2021 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$17,596.53; credits \$4658.35; checking balance \$78,751.21

New Members: Three new members were in attendance and introduced themselves.

Trap range update - The club had another excavator come in and check for sand and gravel at the club. The excavator is interested in working with the club on a 5-10 year lease. They are willing to come in and do site prep for the trap ranges as well. Site prep could start in late spring/early summer.

Membership revoked - recently a member had his membership and use of the range revoked. He was in attendance at the meeting and asked that his membership be reinstated. It was reinstated on a probationary basis.

Kezar Media - Club member Mitch Kezar of Kezar Media told Tom Delaney that if the club ever needed any media coverage that he would be willing to help out as part of his volunteer hours.

Executive Board meeting/Building & Grounds meeting -There will be an Executive Board meeting and a Building and Grounds meeting Tuesday, April 27th. The meeting will start at 6:00 PM, one hour prior to the regular meeting.

25 Yard Range - Improvement projects will be starting on the range in the next month or so. A discussion was had on concerns of rounds leaving the range and possible solutions.

Club patches - The oversized patches are being passed out to the Delano High School trap team kids.

Gun show - The gun show will be on Saturday, April 3rd from 11:00 AM - 3:00 PM. This will be for members only and one guest. Volunteers are needed to help out.

mer league starts on Wednesday, May 5th. There will be a practice night on Thursday April 29th.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
