That's especially true of the enforcement division's conservation officers and staff."

Minutes of April 27th Meeting

36 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the March 30, 2021 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$3155.87; credits \$5024.00; checking balance \$80,619.34

New Members: Five new members were in attendance and introduced themselves.

Trap range update - The new company the club has found to do excavating is ready to start. Mining will come after the trap range. A contract needs to be drawn up before starting. The company will do the excavating in return for sand and gravel. The club was also approved for A \$25,000 matching grant from the DNR for the trap range construction.

Range Issues - shooting lines will be delineated on the 25 yard range. Shooters need to be careful when shooting along the east wall to makes sure they are not angling toward the wall. A reminder that all members are responsible for clean up. There are some enhancements planned for the 25 yard range. They will be drawn up to show the club.

Executive Board meeting/Building & Grounds meeting -There was a meeting held prior to the regular meeting. Items discussed were the trap range, the new overhang on the clubhouse, the 25 yard range improvements, farm clean up and recycled tar for the entryway.

Club patches - The oversized patches are being passed out to the Delano High School trap team kids.

Gun show - The gun show held on April 3rd had a great turn out. There were 7 - 8 distributors that came. Several members attended. Overall it went well. Tom would like to make this an annual event on the second Saturday of January from 11:00am - 3:00pm.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
