38 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the August 31, 2021 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$4,324.91; credits \$10,233.50; checking balance \$68,287.56.

Two new members introduced themselves

Trap range update - Tom Delaney has talked to the contractor and is pushing him to resume work on the range.

25 Yard Range - Reminder that all members are responsible for clean up on the range. Center your targets so the portable target holders don't get destroyed.

Building and Grounds/Executive Committee meetings - There may be a meeting in October or November depending on the progress on the range.

Fourth of July - There was no meeting however Joe Kittok reported that the Fourth of July committee is not letting the Chamber back in but is considering letting the swim team in.

Summer raffle - \$7143.00 was collected. Twenty eight people sold 20 books or more. Tom Bipes sold 46 books, Paul Klesmit sold 40 books. Ed Fransen won the shotgun, Adam Fredrickson won \$250.00, and Roger Fraumen won \$100.00.

Building Addition - Tom met with Mike Stoddard regarding the addition. Mike is willing to help out with the project. Mike had some concerns with the plans - specifically the pitch of the roof and the use of particle board under the tin. Tom will meet with Mike again regarding the plans. Construction prices have come down so Tom will be getting an updated bid. Construction may start in October.

Non member sight in day will be on October 9th. It will be \$15.00 per gun sighted in. The event has been advertised in local newspapers. Flyers are available to put up. They could use one more volunteer for the event.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
