36 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the November 30, 2021 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$10,889.75; credits \$12,369.00; checking balance \$85,445.96.

Two new members introduced themselves.

Election of Officers - President Tom Delaney, Secretary Dan Kittok and Treasurer Joe Kittok were all reelected. Ann Finelli was elected as Third Vice President.

Gun Show - A gun show was held at the club on January 15th, there was a good turnout. The club will continue to put on the gun show every year on the 2nd weekend in January.

Duck Stamp prints - 15 duck stamp prints were donated to the club by a club member. The options are to put them up for display or to auction them off. A motion was made and passed to display the prints at the club for at least a year.

Trap range update - The excavators are taking some sand out now. The excavators will be pursuing a grading permit for the farm where the sand is dug and removed instead of a mining permit where crushing and screening of the gravel takes place. They are going to Franklin township for approval in February and then to the county.

25 Yard Range - Reminder that all members are responsible for clean up on the range.

Building and Grounds Committee meeting - should meet in the next two months.

Executive Committee meeting - To meet after the regular meeting.

2022 FIREARMS SAFETY TRAINING COURSE

Location: Delano Sportsman's Club Course is 4 weeks in length – held Tuesday and Thursday evenings except for March 28th which is on a Monday.

Class Dates and Times are as follows:

- March 15 & 17 7-9pm
- ♦ March 22 & 24 7-9pm
- March 28 & 31 7-9pm
- ◆ April 5 & April 7 7-9pm
- ♦ April 9 Field Day 7am- 12 noon

Students must be 11 years old by class start date. Adults are welcome and encouraged to take this course. A parent or guardian is required to attend the first class on March 15th . There is no course fee. No firearms or ammunition are to be brought to classes by students.

A firearm of some type (i.e., rifle, shotgun, BB gun, etc.... but not pistol) will be needed for the Field Day and each student is encouraged to bring their own. If student cannot bring a firearm, one will be provided to use on Field Day. Do not bring ammunition to Field Day, the instructors will provide ammunition for students .22 rifles. Only .22 caliber will be permitted for firing on Field Day. Field Day will be held rain or shine. Students should dress accordingly.

This Firearms Safety Training Course will cover hunter responsibility, firearm handling, marksmanship, wildlife identification, game management, conservation, game care, outdoor survival, water safety, and first aid awareness.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
