Minutes of the March 29, 2022 meeting

37 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

New members - Three new members introduced themselves

Secretary's report - Minutes of the February 22, 2022 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter. There was an error in the newsletter regarding range shooting times that will be fixed.

Treasurers report - debits \$9,347.59; credits \$5,728.75; checking balance \$79,484.60.

Trap range update - A lease agreement was drawn up by the excavators - New Look Contacting for the club . The lease will be reviewed for signing. The grant for the new trap range is up on June 30th. #### SAFETY RULES

#### "DUMMY" Rounds or Snap Caps

We will be using these on the range at various times to practice loading, unloading, clearing malfunctions and dry fire practice. These are all skills we recommend you practice at home too. They are not expensive and are worth the cost for the training value they provide!

If you are able before May 5, please purchase some for your caliber pistol(s) if you don't already have. You can find them at most gun stores, ranges with retail centers or order online.

Note: The cheaper plastic ones, while less expensive, tend not to last as long and are prone to not properly cycling. Kind of defeats the purpose In my opinion, it is preferable to spend a little more and not have those issues. Here's a few types that many shooters use:

STAction StrikeIndustries NewBold Notes:

If you have a rimfire like a .22 caliber, your only choice may be the plastic. We'll work with what you are able to find.

Some are weighted to feel just like live rounds (more realistic feel while practicing), while others are lightweight. Either choice is fine, but I like the weighted ones. I mix them in by feel with my live rounds to "surprise myself" when practicing clearing malfunctions. (I'll teach ya how to do that too ③)

Brightly colored ones are MUCH easier to find on the range. They go flying everywhere so you have a better chance of finding them!

### Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
