29 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the June 28, 2022 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$5155.16; credits 4528.00; checking balance \$83,989.70.

New Members - Two new members introduced themselves.

Trap range update - Clay is being brought in to level off the area where the trap houses will go. Drainage can be put down. The goal is to get done by the fall.

Trapshooting - Summer league is in their 11th week.

A member will be staining the overhang in the next weeks

25 Yard Range - If you see something wrong on the range, correct it. Correct other members if needed. Try to avoid putting 22 brass in the brass bucket, put in the garbage. Live rounds or misfires are bring found in the brass bucket. A new bucket will be set up for live rounds or misfires.

Building and Grounds - Clean up is being done on the farm

Women's League - Ann Finelli updated the club on the women's shooting group. The group met last week for an event. They shot targets at Cal Brandts. Ten women participated. The ladies are starting to improve their skills. The next event is August 16th. In September they will be doing trap shooting. The Women's League would like permission to use other targets than paper. These would be soft targets that are safe. A motion was made and passed to allow the Women's League to use other targets on the range on league nights.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
