Minutes of the July 26th Meeting

34 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the July 26, 2022 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$4142.37; credits 24,226.48; checking balance \$103,723.78.

Trap range update - Three laterals for drainage have been put in. The next step will be to locate center for the center trap station and work from there to determine the layout of the traps. Also need to determine where the power pole should go to run conduit from there to where the trap houses will be. Then concrete. The goal is to get the center trap range done yet this year. The club is looking for volunteers to help with all aspects of this project. Mark Bauman will be going to the township meeting next Tuesday to renew the clubs conditional use permit for the trap ranges.

Trapshooting - Summer league has three weeks left of league shooting.

The staining of the overhang will be happening soon. The club is looking for volunteers for a variety of things. Volunteers are needed for the Turkey shoot in September, and the non member sight in day in October. The trap shack also needs new shingles and staining.

25 Yard Range - If you see something wrong on the range, correct it. Correct other members if needed. The targets are still getting shot up.

There will be an Executive board meeting/Building and Grounds meeting after the regular meeting in September.

Building and Grounds - Clean up is being done on the farm, Xcel is utilizing their leased portion of the clubs property.

Membership - There have been a lot of requests for membership information. Three new members signed up this past month.

Women's League - Ann Finelli updated the club on the women's shooting group. The group met in August at Cal Brandts to shoot. September 20th will be trap shooting. Eight women have signed up so far. October and through the winter there will be classroom training.

Fourth of July - The club receive an \$18,300.00 payout from the proceeds from the 4th of July celebration. It was a very successful year. Nearly \$300,000.00 was collected, with expenses of around \$85,000.00. \$45,000.00 was held back for next year's expenses. They will be buying another milk shake machine for next year. The bingo stand made \$8000.00. The milk shake stand made \$6500.00. The pedal tractor pull had 59 kids in it this year. Thank you to all the volunteers, it all went well. Joe Kittok would like to have a co chair person with him next year to help out. The Taste of Delano went well. The club went through 15 gallons of ice cream at the event.

Summer Raffle - \$4458.00 has been collected so far. Jan Kittok has additional tickets if you need more.

The club has the opportunity to put on a First Aid Class and a Range Safety Officer class for club members. Contact Tom Delaney if you are interested in these classes.

The members Christmas Party will be held on Friday, December 9th. The Clubs annual gun show will be held the second weekend in January.

The Lake Lillian Sportsmen's club invited us to a BBQ at their club, however it is the same day as our Turkey Shoot.

Steve Bragg requested \$300.00 for advertising for the non member sight in day. A motion was made and passed to provide Steve with \$300.00.

The members only fishing contest was held on July 30th on Buffalo Lake. There were 15 participants with 6 boats. A great time was had by all.

Thank you to Laura Herman for providing lunch for the August meeting. In September Christine Pace will be providing lunch

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:27 PM.



Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
