36 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the August 30, 2022 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$5060.48; checking balance \$100,783.47.

Trap range update - The area has been leveled and seeded and is greening up. Bills for leveling, tiling and grass seed were submitted to the treasurer. The club is looking for a source who does poured footings/walls. Mark Bauman will be meeting with a concrete source regarding the layout for traps one and two. Trap one will be set up for 16-27 yards. trap two will be set up for just 16 yards to start with.

## No monthly club meeting in December

## Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
