Volunteer Credit—What Counts?

Members who volunteer to support the club receive reduced dues of \$50 for the next year. So, what counts?

Hours: 8 hours of time will give you credit to reduce your dues to \$50. So, if you work one 4-hour shift at July 4th, you still need to volunteer 4 more hours...or you and a family member could both volunteer, or you could volunteer for two shifts.

Meeting Lunch: If you make lunch for the members, your groceries (up to \$150) is reimbursed, and you get full credit for volunteer time.

Raffle Tickets: If you sell 20 books of raffle tickets, that meets your full volunteer requirement.

34 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the March 28, 2023 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$19,454.84; credits \$2502; checking balance \$86,000.00

New members - One new members introduced himself.

Trap range update - Mark Bauman updated the club on the new trap range. Mark received one bid so far for the concrete work. He wants to get a couple more bids. The storm water plan for the range has been taken care of.

Gun Show - It has been suggested that the club do another gun show in the summer. After a brief discussion the idea was tabled. It will be brought up again at the May meeting.

25 Yard Range - Targets are still getting beat up on the range. The 50 yard target is busted up and needs some work. Volunteer opportunities are available on the range for clean up and for fixing the 50 yard target.

Excel Energy lease - The lease with Excel Energy should be completed soon. They still have items left on the property. Tom will reach out and talk to them.

Farm - Due to the high water there are vehicles and equipment in the flood zone. Joe will remove them once the water recedes. The townships request was that everything needed to be cleaned up by the end of May. If an extension is needed, it must be asked for at the next township meeting.

Executive Board meeting - the Executive Board will meet next month after the regular meeting.

Firearms safety - Firearms safety completed their field day on April 15th. Dick Nordling was honored for 50 years of teaching firearms safety.

4th of July - Joe is getting supplies ready. They may look to expand seating at the bingo pavilion this year to increase participation. There is room on each end for additional picnic tables. Joe Kittok is still looking for an assistant to help him. If you are interested contact Joe. This is a great volunteer opportunity.

Expo - The Delano Expo will be held on Saturday, May 20th. The club could use one or two more volunteers to work the booth.

Summer raffle - The summer raffle has collected around \$2162.00 so far. See Jan Kittok if you need more tickets to sell.

Membership - The club has 565 members and 77 honorary

members.

Women's League - the Women's league is planning in May to be outside shooting. The schedule is set for the summer and is in the newsletter. In September they will be doing trapshooting again. Attendance has been light during the winter months. The Women's league is looking to grow, contact Ann Finelli if you are interested.

Bird house building will take place on April 29th starting at 9:00 AM. 30 wood duck and 30 blue bird houses will be built this year. Those coming to assemble can take a bluebird or wood duck house home with them, the rest will be given away at the expo.

MNGOPAC/GOCRA - Dave Smith updated the club on bills containing gun control provisions. The petition to stand against SF 1723 is still available to sign. Dave will take the petition to the capital.

Highway 12 trash clean-up will be coming up soon. Contact Dan MacDonald for further details. This is a volunteer opportunity.

Club sign - The design for the sign has been modified to include the ideas presented at the March meeting. The sign will be 4' X 8' and made out of aluminum.

The club is looking for a volunteer or volunteers to pick up brass on the range. Duties would include collecting the brass from the range weekly or bi-monthly depending on the time of year, sorting and taking it in to be recycled.

Lunch was provided by Mike Larison. The club is looking for volunteers to do lunch in June through November.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
