- Dues: 505 paid members, 2 Lifetime members and 90 Honorary members.
- 4th of July Things are progressing. New to the event this year will be a motorcycle show. The Sportsmen's Club will be hosting a trap shoot on July 6th.

- Trapshooting Summer league We are on week nine of summer league. The league is half way through the season
- Range Reservations Rockford Firearms Safety for August 23rd from 8:00 am 1:00 pm was approved
- The club raised prices on pop and water that can be purchased at the meetings. Pop is now \$1.50 per can, water is \$1.00 per bottle.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns.
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a Safety Check before firing.
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden.
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.

Please see the photo of where targets were placed on the range. *This is unacceptable and not allowed on the range. The standing targets cannot be used on the 100/50 yard range.* The rolling 50 yard target should be used on the right side with the 100 yard as the backstop. THANK YOU!
