## **VOLUNTEER CREDIT -**WHAT COUNTS?

Members who volunteer to support the club receive reduced dues of \$50 or \$150 for the next year. So, what counts?

## **MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 26, 2025 MEETING**

37 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:01 PM by President Mike Larison

- Secretary's report Minutes of the July 29, 2025 meeting were approved.
- Treasurers report debits \$4925.41; credits \$920.00; checking balance \$9590.39 Trapshooting Checking: debits \$30298.68; credits \$22294.00; checking balance \$24224.36. Capital Savings account for new trap clubhouse: debits \$13665.00; credits \$1569.00; balance \$8888.52 All reports were approved.
- New members One new member introduced himself.
- Dues: 527 paid members, 2 Lifetime members and 89 Honorary members.
- Building & Grounds The roof to the entry way on the club house needs to be replaced. The roof on the range shack will be done in the next couple weeks. The range shack is now outfitted with a refrigerator, microwave, and pizza oven.
- 4th of July The club received a check for \$10,000.00 for their participation in the celebration. Thank you to everyone who helped out.
- Taste of Delano Thank you to everyone who worked the taste of Delano. Next year the club can decide if they want to continue providing ice cream cones or provide something else.
- Summer raffle \$2280.00 was collected so far. Contact Jan Kittok for extra tickets.
- Trapshooting Summer league There are two weeks of league left.
- Range Reservations The Women's Group would like to reserve the pistol range for Saturday October 4th from 11:15 4:00 and Saturday, November 1st from 11:15 4:00. Both dates were approved.
- Women's Group The August event was cancelled. The next event will be Thursday, September 18. This will be the last event on Thursdays, they will then go to Saturday events.
- Annual Turkey Shoot and Chicken BBQ The chicken halves are on order. Normally the club does 50 halves, it will be reduced to 40 halves this year. Jan Hanson will pick up the turkey certificates. It was approved to get 35 turkey certificates this year. It was approved to spend around \$500.00 for the chicken BBQ this year. The club will need people to donate pot luck dishes for the meal.
- Fundraising Trap Shoot After the turkey shoot on September 6th, there will be a trap shooting fundraiser to raise money for siding for the new trap club house. It will run from Noon 6:00 PM.
- Trap Range fill Multiple loads of fill have been delivered to the trap range and it needs to be spread out. The club is looking for volunteers with skid loaders to help spread it out. Mike Larison will send out a notice.

- Club House Cleaning Club member Diane worked last Thursday cleaning in the club house. It could use more cleaning. A day and time will be set up for volunteers to do more cleaning. The club will look into getting more frequent cleanings set up.
- Members Only Fishing Tournament There was no fishing tournament in 2025. The fishing tournament in 2026 will be on June 20th. A lake will be determined next year.
- Thank You The club received thank you notes from Three Rivers Park District students for the use of the range. The family of Richard Walker sent the club a thank you.
- 990 Status The forms are still in the process of being filled out.
- Farm Property Clean up continues. The red garage is cleaned out. There is a member that will be putting on the garage doors. Everything is out of the lean too's. Some of the volunteer trees have been removed from around the buildings. The shed in the back will be cleaned out next. The Delano Fire Department would still like to use the house to do some training. The club would need to clean up the trash in the house before they could train in it. A motion was made and approved to let the Fire Department use the house for training. The Delano Snowstormers have expressed an interest in renting the red garage. They are still talking about it, no decisions have been made yet.
- New Trap Clubhouse The club house shell is up and the roof is on. Thank you to all the volunteers that helped out. A \$1000.00 donation was just received from a past member. There will be a fundraiser shoot on Saturday, September 6th to raise funds for the siding. Four rolls of 12/2 wire are needed to wire the building if anyone has a roll or partial roll laying around from a past project that you would like to donate, the club could use it. Or if you want to donate your Menards rebate checks to the club to buy some supplies, that would work too.

Thank you to Charlie Grill for providing the August meal. The September meal will be provided by Bobby Weckwerth.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned.

### Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns.
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a Safety Check before firing.
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden.
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.

## **GUN RANGE ISSUE**



Please see the photo of where targets were placed on the range. This is unacceptable and not allowed on the range. The standing targets cannot be used on the 100/50 yard range. The rolling 50 yard target should be used on the right side with the 100 yard as the backstop. THANK YOU!
