VOLUNTEER CREDIT - WHAT COUNTS?

Members who volunteer to support the club receive reduced dues of \$50 or \$150 for the next year. So, what counts?

- Secretary's report - Minutes of the June 30th, 2026 meeting were approved.
- Treasurers report - debits \$6,452.99; credits \$2,131.00; checking balance \$24,097.23 - Trapshooting Checking: debits \$26,754.26; credits \$13,693.54; checking balance \$13,195.64. Capital Savings account for new trap clubhouse: debits \$0.00; credits \$1.79; balance \$5,739.93 All reports were approved.
- New Members – 2 new member introduced themselves
- Members - 526 paid members for 2026, 2 Lifetime members and 89 Honorary member
- Building & Ground – Clubhouse roof need work and the material is on site.
- Members raffle – Jan has tickets for the next raffle in September, we need more members to sell tickets.
- 4th of July – The club received a check for \$15,000.00 for volunteering this year.
- Trapshooting School League – Done for the school year.
- Summer Trap League – They are on week 12 and the trap club house now has AC.
- Legislative – The gun owners caucus has put their support behind Lisa Demuth for MN Governor
- Range Reservations – September 12th is the Turkey shoot. October 10th will be range sight-in day.

- Women's Group - The group is always looking for new members
- New Business – Clean up day for the range is October, contact Taylor for volunteer opportunities
- We talked about the cost for a new security camera system for the range and clubhouse. \$6,185.00 for 8 total cameras at the gun range. A motion was made to approve the purchase of the new camera system. The motion passed.
- Website – The new Membership packets are now available on the website.
- 2027 Membership cards – The new cards are now available with no end date.
- Motion to spend \$300 for new range targets was made. Motion passes.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:25 pm.

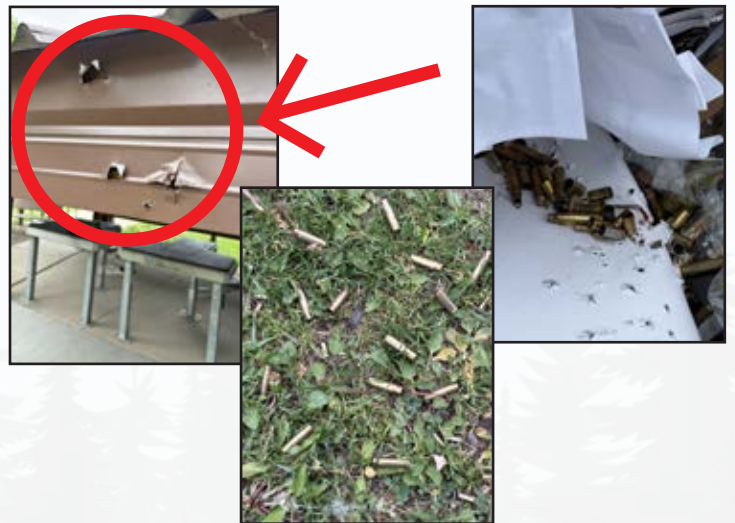

Range Rules:

1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
2. **Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.**
Guests *must* be accompanied by the member.
3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
4. No Paintball guns.
5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
8. Do not dig in the backstops.
9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
14. **Check unknown people for membership cards.**
15. Do a Safety Check before firing.
16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden.
17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.

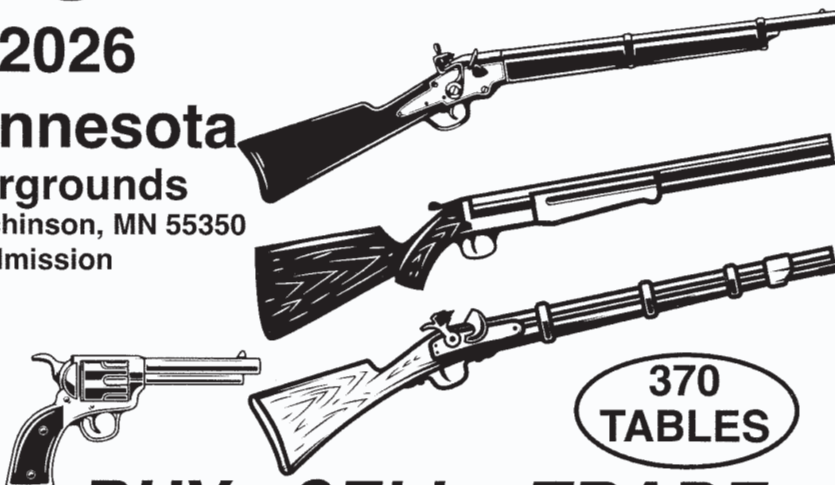

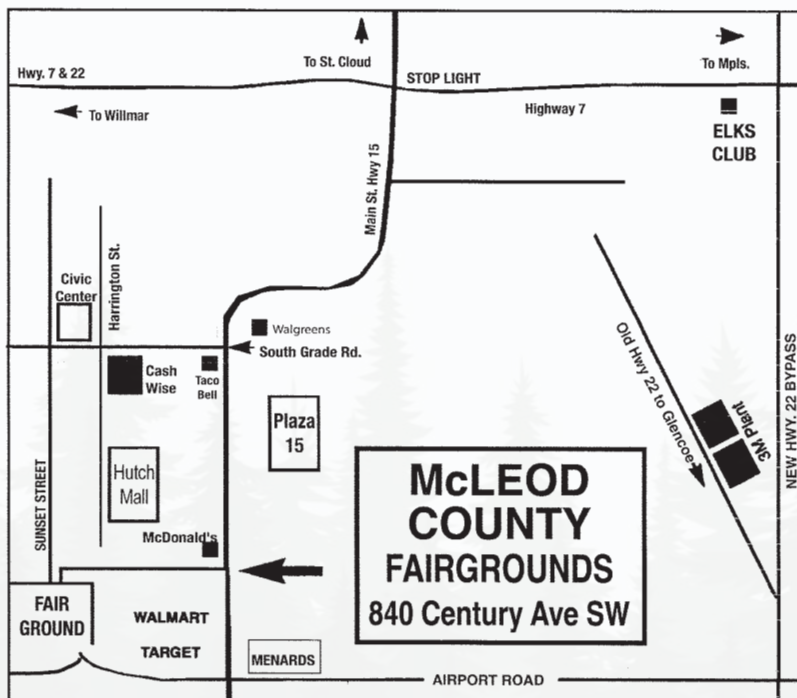
