Minutes of the March 27th 2018 Meeting

41 members present- the meeting called to order at 7:02 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the February 28, 2018 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits - \$12,281.17; credits - \$3625.00; checking balance \$77,387.56. Treasurers report was approved.

Gravel mining - Joe White from Ram Excavating updated the club. The permit has been started, plans are being drawn up now. Joe will get a copy of the final plans to the club. When completed the application will be turned in to get on the planning and zoning meeting. Joe figures it will be about 60 days before he will be able to start.

Jay Braegleman spoke to the club about putting up a self serve wood hut. He would like to put a self serve wood hut on the property to sell bundles of certified wood. He has a few of these huts in the area. Permission was given to put up the hut.

Trap Range update - The range is getting a lot of support from the community. The club has been served with a petition to get an environmental study done on the site of the proposed trap range. Mark will arrange to get this done. All members are encouraged to attend the upcoming meetings regarding the trap range -Thursday, 3/29/18 Planning and Zoning at the court house in Buffalo, Monday, 4/2/18 Franklin Township Hall, Thursday, 4/19/18 Planning and Zoning at the court house in Buffalo. A discussion was had on how best to deal with the opposition to the club regarding the trap range. Motion was made to table the discussion until the next meeting.

Glass has been ordered to fix the broken windows on the trap shack. The windows will need to be glazed if anyone would like to volunteer.

Farm House - there are a number of volunteer projects to be done at the farm house.

Building and Grounds Committee - we will look to have a meeting in May.

Membership - there has been a few new members signing up recently.

Executive Board meeting - there will be an executive board meeting after the regular meeting in April.

Fourth of July - the has been no meeting since last month. The club is to staff the milk shake booth and the bingo stand. The Boy Scouts will be helping in the hamburger stand this year. The club also organizes and runs the pedal tractor pull. Shifts are available in the bingo stand and milk shake booth. Contact Jan Kittok to volunteer.

Wright County Federation of Sportsmen's Club - After nearly 50 years the club has dissolved due to lack of support and participation. There used to be many clubs involved in it, the last few years there has only been five. The money left in the account has been split between the five remaining clubs with the stipulation that it be shared with the Delano Trap Team.

Gun Control legislation - Dan Mac-Donald updated the club, there will be a rally at the capital at noon on April 28th. Legislators, representatives and the media will be there. The rally held a month ago, gun owners outnumbered the anti gun owners 120 to 1.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
