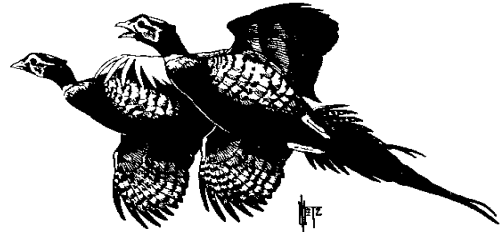

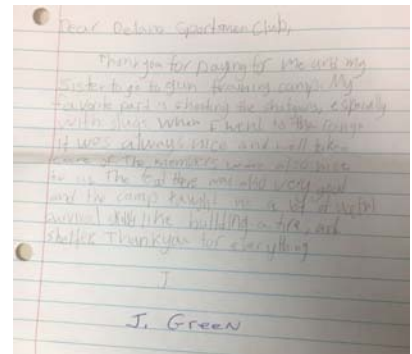

Minutes of the July 31st 2018 Meeting

34 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:01 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the June 26, 018 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter

Treasurers report - debits \$4797.91; credits \$5131.50; checking balance \$57,415.87. Treasurers report was approved.

One new member was present and introduced himself.

Congratulations to the Delano Tiger Trap Shooting Team for taking second place in Nationals out of 173 teams.

Mike Kaczmarek who is running for Wright County Sheriff spoke to the club regarding his platform.

Gravel mining - Tom Delaney, Mark Bauman and Joe White had a meeting with the planning and zoning commissioners. An environmental impact study may need to be done before proceeding any farther.

Trap range update - There is one more vote on August 9th, to decide if it is approved.

Range issues - There have been no complaints since the new signs were put up. Tom Delaney replaced the retractable targets on the 25 yard range as they were shot up pretty bad over the fourth of July week. A spotting scope was found on the range if anyone is missing one. The rubber tracks that we felt could work as bullet catchers on the range have a downside - it would cost \$200-\$300 to dispose of them if we would have to.

Membership - five new members joined in the last month.

Executive Board - the Executive board will meet after the regular meeting in August.

Fourth of July - Joe Kittok had a meeting with Alex Roeser to go over

things that went wrong in the milk shake stand this year. There was one machine that kept freezing up and a variety of supplies that were missing. Next year they will rent better machines. Only one mixer was rented this year - next year they would like four. And they will rearrange the stand for next year. It looks like it will be a successful year for the club and the whole Fourth of July celebration. Thank you to everyone who helped. The bingo stand benches were discussed, Joe will talk to the city to see if they will improve them and make the bingo stand handicap accessible.

Range reservations - Three Rivers Park District for 9/5/18 from noon - 6:00PM, and 11/28/18 from 4:00PM - 9:00Pm were approved.

Club House reservations - Carol Dobbelaire for 12/1/18 for a Christmas boutique was approved.

Gun Control Legislation - Jeff Johnson is the most 2nd amendment friendly candidate for Governor. The DFL will have gun grabbers as candidates.

Raffle tickets for the September raffle are available from Jan Kittok. \$2500 has been received so far.

Feedback on the new shooting benches has been mostly positive, there have been some complaints though.

Joe Kittok and Tom Delaney met with the bank and signed a new five year loan on the property. The interest rate went up a bit from the first loan.

Taste of Delano will be held on Wednesday, August 1st from 5:00PM - 8:00PM in the city park. Tickets are \$10:00 at the gate.

The club has discount Game Fair tickets available.

The members only fishing contest will be held on August 25th.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM

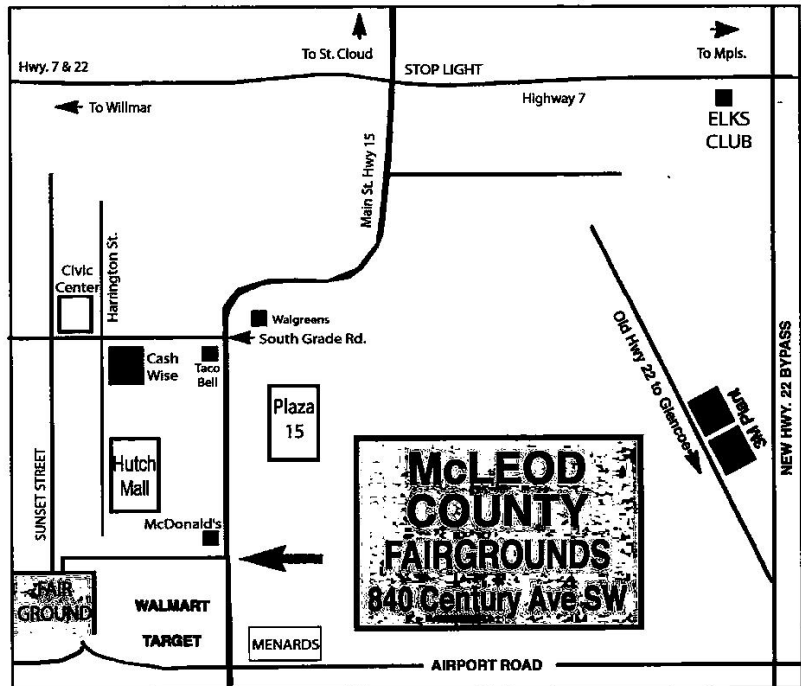

Range Rules:

1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
4. No Paintball guns
5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
8. Do not dig in the backstops.
9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. **Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.**
10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
