Minutes of the January 31st, 2017 Meeting

3 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the November 9, 2016 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits for December 2016 \$3628.4; credits for December 2016 \$14,826.6. Debits for January \$9477.81; credits for January \$20,511.00. Checking balance \$59,013.25. Treasurers report was approved.

Elections for treasurer and secretary were held - Joe Kittok will remain as treasurer, Dan Kittok will remain as secretary. Tom Delaney agreed to continue as President for another year.

Mark Bauman gave an update to the club on the progress of the new trap range. Mark met with Bob Russek who will be doing the site plan for the range. Two site options were identified. One option is less intrusive than the other and has less issues with it. Mark would like to move forward with the site plan on the less intrusive option. Authorization was given to Mark to proceed.

Law Enforcement Officers Conceal and Carry forum has been rescheduled to Wednesday, February 15th at 7:00 PM. West Hennepin has committed to coming. Tom will be inviting other police forces as well.

Other upcoming round table events are: Law Enforcement Officers appreciation on 7/11/17, First Aid on 9/12/17, Supressors and Sights sometime in May, Delano Chamber meeting - the date is not set yet.

25 yard range improvements - There are instances where bullets ricochet into the garage. Future improvements are to build a concrete wall on the driveway side. This would then allow for a bullet catcher and future roof. The improvements would lessen noise and increase safety.

Approval has been given by the executive committee to build the wall. A motion was made and passed by the club to proceed with the wall. A suggestion was made to look into improving the drainage of the driveway as long as work was being done on that side of the range.

Grounds Improvement - It has been brought up that we should start improving the habitat on the farm this year, suggestions are to plant trees and pheasant habitat. The club should think about what can be done and it can be discussed again at the February meeting.

Tom Delaney bought 50 hunting DVD's and is donating them to the club. A DVD library will be set up for club members to use and share DVD's. More donations are welcome.

Membership is now at 88% paid.

Fourth of July - February 13th will be the first meeting of the Fourth of July committee. There is another spot available for a Sportsmen's club member to join in on the meetings with Joe Kittok and Mike Speckle, if anyone is interested.

The members only raffle brought in \$2020.00. Scott Yunker won the Savage 22 rifle, Brian Baumann won a year's membership to the club.

GOCRA & MNGOPAC - Dan MacDonald updated the club that nothing

is immediately happening with the legislature right now. It is encouraged to give your e mail address to GOCRA & MNGOPAC to get up to date e mails on what is getting into committee.

Range Reservations - Brad Spencer and Jan Kittok are handling reservations this year. A list of reservations have be submitted and passed and will be listed in the newsletter. Reservations passed for Dan MacDonald to reserve the 25 yard range for May 13th and September 9th for the people helping out with the highway 12 clean up on those days.

Think about how the club wants to handle hunting on the property, this will be discussed at future meetings.

Information is available on the West Hennepin Citizens Police Academy. Another academy will be starting on February 16th and will run seven weeks, if anyone is interested.

Lunch for the January meeting was provided by the Lucky Fives trap team. The February lunch will be provided by Coborns.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:40 PM.

2017 FIREARMS SAFETY TRAINING COURSE

Registration date is March 6th from 7:00pm to 8:00pm at the Delano Sportsman's Club. There is a NO registration fee. A parent or guardian is required to register each student.

No online registration / No phone registration / Class has no size limit

Students must be 11 years old by registration date. Adults are welcome and encouraged to take this course. Class hour are 7:00 to 9:00 each night. Saturday, April 1st is the Field/Range Day from 7:00 a.m. to about 1:00 p.m. A parent or guardian is requested to attend the March 7th class from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

NO firearms or ammunition are to be brought to classes by students. A firearm of some type (i.e. rifle, shotgun, BB gun, etc.) will be needed for the Field/Range Day for each student. Do not bring ammunition for this day. If you have no firearm, one will be provided to shoot on the range.

Field/Range Day will be held rain or shine. Students should dress accordingly.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. No digging in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
