# Minutes of the January 29th 2019 Meeting

21 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the November 27, 2018 meeting were approved with the following change. The meeting minutes were labeled as October and should have been November.

Treasurers report - debits \$16,210.06; credits \$31,527.10; checking balance \$74,007.56. Treasurers report was approved.

One new member introduced himself.

Three Delano Junior high students did a project on the second amendment - it can be viewed at https://youtu.be/6TWOkwcN19g

Elections: Tom Delaney would like to stay on for another year as President - motion passed. Tim Robbins resigned as 1st Vice President so John Tackaberry moves up to 1st Vice President, Cal Brandt moves up to 2nd Vice President, Bert Neuenschwander was nominated for 3rd Vice President, accepted the nomination and it passed. Dan Kittok agreed to remain as Secretary and Joe Kittok agreed to remain as Treasurer - both passed.

Members only raffle - Steve Bragg is the winner and picked the shotgun.

Gravel mining - Joe White talked to the Soil and Water and the Corp of Engineers regarding his plan. Joe had to change a few things on the drawing and the order of mining but all is good now with both parties. The plan will be submitted to the county and will go through the process for approval.

Trap range update - The county's decision to approve the clubs expansion of the trap range is being challenged in the Court of Appeals. A lot of ground work was done on the trap range this past fall.

25 Yard Range - Half of the 25 yard range is now open for shooting this

winter. The club is looking at different ideas for a backstop - to be built in the spring. And ideas for sound abatement.

Building and Grounds Committee -We will look to have a committee meeting in March. The club may expand the committee due to the new trap range.

Membership - 85% of dues have been paid.

Executive Board - There will be an executive board meeting in February.

Fourth of July Committee will have their first meeting of the year in February.

GOCRA & MNGOPAC - Dan Mac-Donald updated the club on the legislature. There are three pro gun bills in the house right now, but they are unlikely to get out of the house. There are six anti gun bills. Keep pressure on your legislators.

Summer Raffle - Prizes will be \$100, \$250 and a gun to be decided on.

Reservations - Law Enforcement, Summer Camps, Federal Task Force, Boy Scouts, Firearms Safety and others all requested their dates for the year. The dates are similar to last year's usage of the club and range. The dates were all accepted.

### **Old Business**

The club received information on a range conference and grant money that is available.

Christmas Party - There was an excellent turn out, the food was good, there prizes were good. A good time was had by all.

Police Appreciation meeting - The Delano Lions are hosting a Police Appreciation meeting at the Legion Club in Delano in May. The intent is to get as many law enforcement personnel to attend and honor them by having a dinner. The club is available to help out.

**New Business** 

Gun Rally - February 23rd - There will be a gun rally at the capitol. The club would like to get a bus to go down to it and is looking for input regarding the idea. Once the details have been decided, they will be put in an email to the club members.

# 2019 FIREARMS SAFETY TRAINING COURSE

Registration date is March 11<sup>th</sup> from 7:00pm to 8:00pm at the Delano Sportsman's Club. There is a NO registration fee. A parent or guardian is required to register each student.

No online registration / No phone registration / Class has no size limit

Students must be 11 years old by registration date. Adults are welcome and encouraged to take this course. Class hour are 7:00 to 9:00 each night. Saturday, April 6th is the Field/Range Day from 7:00 a.m. to about 1:00 p.m. A parent or guardian is requested to attend the March 12<sup>th</sup> class from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Class dates are as follows:

March 12, 14 April 2, 4 March 19, 21 April 6 Field Day March 25, 28

**NO** firearms or ammunition are to be brought to classes by students. A firearm of some type (i.e. rifle, shotgun, BB gun, etc.) will be needed for the Field/Range Day for each student. Do not bring ammunition for this day. If you have no firearm, one will be provided to shoot on the range.

Field/Range Day will be held rain or shine. Students should dress accordingly.

The Firearm Safety Training Course will cover hunter responsibility, firearms handling, marksmanship, wildlife identification, game management and game care, survival, water safety and first aid.

# Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
