## Minutes of the November 29th, 2016 Meeting

Meeting called to order by Pres. Tom Delaney

New members introduced themselves.

Secretary's report accepted as printed in club newsletter

Treasures report read and received motion to accept, second, and carried. Debits \$6,548.74 Income \$7,831.56 Balance \$32,131.29

Now that there is a renter in the farm house, there will be a separate financial report each month for the farm and for the club. That way we can track expenses for each more easily.

Mark Bauman gave an update to members on progress on the possibility of new trap range on the farm property.

Pres. Delaney briefed members on upgrade to 25 yard range and upcoming committee meetings.

Members were reminded to check the newsletter for range activities. That will let them know when events are scheduled.

As of meeting date we have \$1,200 in for the membership raffle. All memberships must be paid by Dec 31 to enter raffle.

Dan McDonald spoke on election results and upcoming legislative session and what we should watch for.

Work is progressing on the farm house. Renter will be able to occupy soon. Separate financial reports will begin on farm and club in 2017

Twenty six percent of 2016 members have paid dues for 2017.

A tenative schedule for 2017 has been set for informational meetings. February will be law enforcement, April will be scopes and suppressors, June will be a law enforcement round table, and September will be first aid for shooters.

John Tackaberry suggested we host a law enforcement night for club members only, motion was made, second and carried.

The club property is posted as "NO HUNTING". We have had at least 2 individuals invited to leave the property. One individual said he had permission to hunt but it was not from a member of the club. In the future we

will need to decide if we will allow hunting and if so, how do we control it.

There were no requests for range or club house reservations.

The Minn DNR is again offering grant monies to clubs for upgrade projects. Anyone who is interested on working on receiving a grant see Tom Delaney.

The Delano Snowstormers have inquired about a donation for their fundraiser. There was a motion to donate a 1 year membership, received a second, and carried.

There will be no meeting in December.

## 2017 FIREARMS SAFETY TRAINING COURSE

Registration date is March 6<sup>th</sup> from 7:00pm to 8:00pm at the Delano Sportsman's Club. There is a NO registration fee. A parent or guardian is required to register each student.

No online registration / No phone registration / Class has no size limit

Students must be 11 years old by registration date. Adults are welcome and encouraged to take this course. Class hour are 7:00 to 9:00 each night. Saturday, April 1<sup>st</sup> is the Field/Range Day from 7:00 a.m. to about 1:00 p.m. A parent or guardian is requested to attend the March 7<sup>th</sup> class from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

**NO** firearms or ammunition are to be brought to classes by students. A firearm of some type (i.e. rifle, shotgun, BB gun, etc.) will be needed for the Field/Range Day for each student. Do not bring ammunition for this day. If you have no firearm, one will be provided to shoot on the range.

Field/Range Day will be held rain or shine. Students should dress accordingly.

### Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. No digging in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.

  Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
