40 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:01 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the May 29, 2018 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter

Treasurers report - debits -\$18411.66; credits - \$9460.78; checking balance \$59,153.54. Treasurers report was approved.

Kristina Tulke introduced herself and thanked the club for sponsoring her as a candidate for Miss Delano.

Gravel mining - There has been a negative social media post on the Delano Community site regarding the mining proposal. Joe White and his engineer will be at the clubhouse Wednesday night at 7:00 PM to meet with concerned neighbors and answer any questions they have regarding the mining proposal.

Trap range update - The planning and zoning meeting at Wright County on June 7th was a good meeting. There was a hang up by the committee on the sound engineers findings regarding the one house failing the sound decibel level at extreme conditions with no foliage. The sound engineer made a mistake in his calculations, everything passes now. Verification of the mistake was sent to Wright County Planning and Zoning. The next meeting will be Thursday, June 28 at the courthouse at 7:30 PM.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
