Minutes of the February 28th 2017 Meeting

26 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the January 31, 2017 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits\$9954.63; credits\$3930.10; checking balance \$52,988.72. Treasurers report was approved.

Mark Bauman updated the club on the new trap range - Mark is working with Bob Russek to get a site plan made.

The Law enforcement roundtable on conceal and carry was held on February 15th. Twenty five people were in attendance. A couple police officers and a conservation officer attended. The night went well. The club will continue to do roundtable forums. Law Enforcement appreciate is on July 11, 2017, Hunter First Aid is on September 12, 2017 and we are looking in my to have a suppressors and sights forum.

The club will be putting up a cement wall on the driveway side of the 25 yard range for additional safety and seclusion. Tom is in the process of getting bids.

Club farmhouse and land - Joe and Jan Kittok will start renting the house in March. A proposal was made and passed to plant trees on the berm this spring. 150 black hills spruce and 50 crab apple were suggested. The cost will not exceed \$300. Tree plantings for windrows will come later. The question was brought up about whether to allow hunting on the property. The discussion was that it was not logical based on what we are trying to do with the property.

DVD Library - a cabinet will be coming soon for the DVD's. Any members who have hunting, fishing or wildlife DVD's they would like to donate are encouraged to do so.

Membership - Eighty members did not renew their memberships this past year. This happens every year. New members are being signed up.

There was a request from FTF in St Paul to use the range for 8 days this year. There are 36 members of FTF and they will pay \$3000 to use the range for those eight days. Dates have been placed on the calendar. This is the first year for the FTF to use the range. We will re-evaluate how it went, if they wish to come back next year. Tom Delaney will be present on the range the first day they use it. The executive committee approved the request, a motion was made and passed by the membership to allow the FTF to use the range.

Fourth of July - Shifts are available in the bingo stand and milk shake booth. There may not be a spot for the carnivals RV's to park this year. Joe Kittok volunteered the clubs five acres by the bridge as a possible parking area if needed.

Dick Nordling informed the club that the Fathers Day Shoot will only be one day this year. It has not been decided yet if it will be Saturday or Sunday.

Summer Trap Shooting league will start in mid April.

GOCRA & MNGOPAC - Dan Mac-Donald updated the club that "Constitutional Carry" is being discussed, and to not support Minnesota Gun Rights Organization. They are not lobbyist, the organization is out of Iowa and they are an enemy to our cause.

Range and Club reservations have been updated on the calendar on the web site. All dates have been approved.

DNR Firearms Instructor class will be held at the club on March 18th from noon - 4:00 PM. There are nine people

signed up to take the class. If anyone is interested in being an instructor or has questions, contact Tom Delaney.

The Delano Expo is on Saturday, April 1st. Joe Kittok will be in charge of our booth again, volunteers are needed.

John Tackaberry informed the club about Thurman Tucker. Thurman mentors inner city kids and takes them on outdoor outings. John felt it would be a good idea to have Thurman and the kids come out to the club. John will look into getting them out here.

The club will be sending six kids to camp this year, there is still one opening left.

Pete Bauman would like to come back and talk to the club at the May meeting. Pete was the recipient of one of the first scholarships the club gave out.

Lunches for the meetings are covered through June. July - September is open if anyone would like to volunteer.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. No digging in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
