## Minutes of the February 27th 2018 Meeting

35 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the January 30, 2018 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits - \$4765.48; credits - \$12,034.75; checking balance \$88,762.73. Treasurers report was approved.

One guest present - Joe White from Ram Excavating

One new member present.

Joe White from Ram Excavating spoke to the club regarding gravel on the property. Joe drilled the farm property for sand and gravel and found that there is about 1 million yards a gravel on the property. Royalty rates to the club for Ram Excavating to mine it would be \$1.00 per yard. The gravel is not in the location of the new trap shooting range. As a condition of mining Joe said they could move the dirt for the new trap shooting ranges. Once the gravel is mined they could makes a series of ponds or a lake. The mining would take place over about ten years. It is possible the club would also be able to sell wetland credits from producing the ponds. A plan would need to be developed that the club and Ram Excavating would be in agreement to. Joe was looking for authorization from the club to proceed with the plans, permitting and agreement. Motion was made to start the process to move forward. Motion was passed. Joe will come to the March meeting to give an update on the process.

The club will be giving away another Henry rifle. Everyone in attendance at this meeting and the next few will get a chance in the drawing. The drawing will be held after a couple more meetings.

Trap range - Mark Bauman gave an update on the progress of the trap range. The final plans are in place. Mark preliminarily met with Franklin township to explain to them what the club is proposing. Mark met with the Chamber, the Lions and they are behind it. Mark has letters of support from the City of Independence, West Hennepin Police and will be getting a letter from Three Rivers Park District. Brad Spencer met with the Delano School superintendent for the schools support but he did not commit to signing a letter of recommendation. The next step will be to present the proposal to the cities and township.

Building and Grounds - Tom feels we will need to add a couple people to the Building and Grounds committee to stay on top of things should the gravel deal progress.

92% of membership is paid up for 2018.

Gun Control legislation - Dan Mac-Donald updated the club on current legislation. This session the legislature is trying to ban everything. They are bringing up absolutely everything hoping that something will stick. There is a hearing Thursday morning at the capitol. Protestors will be there it is important that gun owners be there as well. If anyone is able to go down to the capitol on Thursday in support of your gun owning rights please do. Brad Spencer will put up a link on the website with the information on where to go. Call or write to your legislators to make your opinion known that you are opposed to any infringements on your gun owning rights.

Fourth of July - Joe Kittok attended the recent Fourth of July meeting -The city received a grant to build a new concession building and buy equipment for it. They will be buying two milk shake machines for this year, instead of renting the trailer. The pay structure will be changing this year. It will be based on hours and where worked. The club still needs to supply help, we will find out what we get paid after.

Trap shooting - A new trap thrower

has been ordered, it has not been delivered yet. A sheet of trap shooting guidelines was developed. It pertains to rules and courtesy that should be followed for trap shooting.

Reservation dates for Deephaven Police, Park Sportsmen's Club firearms safety, MN DNR conservation officer firearms safety and DEA were all passed.

The DEA will be paying the club \$3000.00 this year for eight days of use.

Boy Scout Range use - The Boy Scouts require an NRA certified rifle instructor on the range with them, otherwise they cannot shoot. Is anyone certified that can assist them?

25 yard range wall - Bids are needed for the wall. If you know of any concrete guys, please let Tom Delaney know.

Raffle tickets for the September raffle have been ordered.

Thank you to Linda Lindstrom for providing lunch. Coborns will be providing lunch for the March meeting.

Saturday night is the chamber dinner at the Legion Club in Delano. There will be a silent and live auction, dinner and a show.

## Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
