Minutes of the March 26th 2019 Meeting

37 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the March 26, 2019 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$12,531.04; credits \$2436.25; checking balance \$52,108.53. After questions regarding the phone bill and Wright County property taxes the treasurers report was approved.

Four new members introduced themselves.

Gravel mining/Ram Excavating -New mining drawings were prepared. Ram Excavating will resubmit them to the Corp of Engineering and the Soil and Water department to make sure everything is in order, then they will submit them to the Wright County planning commission for the 30 day comment period. Following that it should come up for a vote. We should know the outcome in 6 - 8 weeks.

Trap range update - The court of appeals hearing was on April 3rd. It will take 60 - 90 days before they make a determination.

Range Issues - The range is a mess. Work needs to be done on the 25 yard range to get it down to grade. Range work day is on Sunday, May 5th. Tom will send out an email to notify people. The club needs shovel ready volunteers to show up for this to help fix up the range. On the 100 yard range the roof will be pulled off the bullet catcher and will be cleaned up. Tom received a complaint on how bad the range looks.

Farm - there is clean up to do at the farm.

Membership - a few new members recently signed up.

Fourth of July Committee - More and more activities are being added every year to keep people down at the park. The club is guaranteed \$5500 this year for our participation in the event. It could go higher depending on the outcome. It has been as high as \$10,000. The club is looking for volunteers to man shifts in the bingo stand and the milk shake booth. Summer Trap League - May 1, summer trap league starts.

GOCRA & MNGOPAC - Dan MacDonald updated the club on the legislature. The scorecard is out on the house members that voted for and against the omnibus bill that contained the gun control bills. It passed 70 - 64. Call your legislators if they didn't vote the way you wanted them to.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
