Ethan and Ashley thanked the club for sponsoring them to pheasant camp this summer.

Trap range - the club is waiting for information in relation to the waiver requested.

25 yard range - There are three broken windows in the trap shack, does the club have any volunteers that are capable of replacing them? One of the retractable targets needs work, Tom will fix it. The club is looking for new bids for the concrete wall.

Farm house - there are a couple of volunteer projects available to do at the farm house - painting and installing garage doors - call Joe Kittok if you are interested volunteering for them.

DVD Library - donations continue to be made.

Building and Grounds will meet after the October meeting.

There will be and Executive Board meeting after the November meeting.

Membership - new membership has been slow lately.

Members who paid the volunteer fee for the current calendar year, but failed to perform or report their volunteer service by 12/31 will be charged the non-volunteer membership fee.

### From the DNR-Register your Deer

Hunters are reminded to register deer before processing, before antlers are removed and within 48 hours after taking the animal, according to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.

"Deer registration provides information that is essential to our ability to manage deer populations," said Steve Merchant, wildlife populations and regulations manager. "Hunters are required to register deer and it's a fairly simple process."

Hunters register deer with a phone call, online or in person. Before registering a deer, hunters must validate their site tag. The validated tag must be attached to the deer when the deer is placed on a motor vehicle or an ATV, a vehicle or a trailer being towed by an ATV or brought into a camp, yard or other place of habitation.

#### Phone registration

Register deer via phone by calling 888-706-6367. Directions are printed on each deer hunting license. Have a pen or permanent marker ready. A confirmation number will be given; it must be written on the license and site tag.

#### **Internet registration**

Register deer via internet at <a href="mmdnr.gov/gameregistration">mmdnr.gov/gameregistration</a>. Directions will be similar to phone registration, and a confirmation number must be written on the license and site tag.

#### **In-person registration**

When phone or internet registration is not possible, hunters must take their deer to a big-game registration station. The person whose name appears on the license must be present at the registration station with their deer. They will receive a big-game possession tag that must be attached to the hind leg, ear or antler where the site tag was attached. A list of all stations organized by city and county is available at any DNR wildlife office or at <a href="mailto:mndnr.gov/hunting/deer">mndnr.gov/hunting/deer</a>.

During registration, the hunter must use the permit area number where the deer was harvested; using the wrong deer permit area for registration is illegal. Registration instructions for all methods are available at mndnr.gov/gameregistrationhelp.

### **Volunteer Needs**

### Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. No digging in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official police events.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
