## Minutes of the August 28th 2018 Meeting

34 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the July 31, 2018 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter

Treasurers report - debits \$4171.85; credits \$2202.00; checking balance \$59,329.57. Treasurers report was approved.

Two new members were present and introduced themselves.

Gravel mining - there is a planning and zoning meeting on Thursday, August 30 at Wright County courthouse at 7:30. An environmental assessment needs to be done, this could take 2-3 months. Tom Delaney spoke with a member who is an environmental consultant, he offered to assist if needed.

Trap range update - The trap range was approved, however some residents are filing suit challenging the county's approval for the range. Tom has an attorney (that specializes in shooting range issues) that he will call to be put on as attorney of note for the club. A motion was made and passed to allow up to \$500 for attorney costs. Mark Bauman met with Dave Matter construction regarding the excavating and pipe size needed for storm water removal for the new range. The cost could be as much as \$30,000. Dave Matter Construction would be available in September to do it if we decide to.

Range issues - A post on the 52 yard range was intentionally shot up over the weekend. Tom Delaney replaced it temporarily so it is up and working now. Discussion on ideas for what is needed to be done to catch the persons responsible for destruction like this will be taken up at the Executive Board meeting.

Building and Grounds - The new wall for the 25 yard range should be started in October. Once wall is up an idea for further sound abatement would be to put up trusses with padding on them.

Membership - four new members joined in the last month.

Executive Board - the Executive Board will meet after the meeting.

Fourth of July - there has not been a committee meeting since the fourth. Joe Kittok has met with members of the committee regarding ways to make the milk shake booth run smoother next year. Joe will be visiting a facility that has the equipment needed for the milk shake booth.

Trap Shooting - There are two league nights left. Party night will be on September 20th.

Gun Control Legislation - Jeff Johnson will be debating Tim Walz at the fair on Friday, August 31.

Raffle tickets for the September raffle are available from Jan Kittok. \$2942 has been received so far.

The members only Turkey Shoot will be held on September 8th from 9:00am - noon.

The Club will be having another First Aid night this year on September 11th at 7:00PM.

The new benches on the rifle range are working out well.

The rubber tracks that we thought would work as bullet catchers on the range could be expensive to dispose of. We will continue to look at alternatives.

The club signed a new 5 year note on the loan for the farm. There is about \$250,000 left to pay on it.

The members only fishing tournament was held on Saturday, August 25th. Six boats participated. There were a lot of nice fish caught.

The Highway 12 clean up will be on Saturday, September 15th. Contact

Dan MacDonald for details. They meet for breakfast in Delano at 7:00am and at Monies in Maple Plain at 8:00am to start the clean up.

The club is investigating insurance coverage for the Executive Board. Information on options and cost are being looked at.

Thank you to Bert Neuenschwander for providing lunch for the meeting. David Smith will provide lunch for the September meeting. October is open if anyone wants to volunteer to provide lunch.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:34 PM.

- We need a volunteer to make and paint a sign with the range rules, and install it by the 100-yard range. Contact Tom Delaney if interested.



## **Range Rules:**

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
